## About the Performance & Workshops

**PEACE by PEACE** is a play that explores various forms of violence in the lives of young people. Using a montage of scenes and monologues, **PEACE by PEACE**, illustrates the effects of gang violence, domestic violence, peer pressure, teen relationship abuse and other issues faced by youth today. Various mediums such as *rap*, *spoken word*, and *music* are woven together to create a performance that comes directly from youth to youth. This 45 minute play uses youth peer educators and professional actors. **PEACE by PEACE** has been performed in over 20 public high schools throughout New York City and is now entering its third season.

After the performance **HAI's** trained facilitators conduct participatory theatrical role-play workshops to help youth examine potentially violent situations. The goals are to help youth understand how violence when used to build their self image can be self-destructive and to explore alternatives through development leadership & mediation skills.
